DANA'S DIRECTION "When Does Life Begin?"



About the only way people have been able to make the practice of abortion palatable to society is to mask the fact that the unwanted and aborted child is different only by the degree it is developed to the cute little bundle welcomed and placed with loving arms in the hospital nursery. Because the random murder of babies would be unthinkable, the term "fetus" is used to dehumanize the unborn. What exactly is a "fetus?" Just an unformed mass of tissue? Is it not any more significant for a pregnant woman to "choose" to have a fetus removed than it would be to remove a cyst or other tumor?

Thirty five years ago, I ran into my first Christian who challenged my teaching on abortion. They said, that while they did not advocate abortion, the Bible was silent on the issue and that one could not really determine when life actually began. On the other hand, I certainly believe that the Bible does not reveal the time God recognizes life and condemns specifically those who would "shed innocent blood." (Proverbs 6:17)

James wrote, "For as the body without the spirit is dead..." (James 2:26) I realize that James was speaking of the role of faith and works, but he illustrated that by comparing to a known fact—a body without a spirit within is dead. Since an unborn baby (fetus) is obviously alive, it has a spirit within. Since there is no time in the fetus's development when it is not living or not human, we conclude that the time "God forms the spirit within man" (Zechariah 11:1) is at conception. An even stronger statement of this fact are the words of Solomon, "As you do not know how the spirit comes to the bones in the womb of a woman with child, so you do not know the work of God who makes everything." (Ecclesiastes 11:5 RSV)

The idea that a baby is spiritless for nine months is an insult to the God who created man "in His own image." (Genesis 1:26) The unborn baby is human life, made so by the soul that God created and placed within the forming body. As God said to Jeremiah, "before I formed you in the womb, I knew you." (Jerimah1:5)

Isn't the only issue the fact that some children are wanted and some are not? The same fetus that is born premature, and with the help of modern medical technology grows to be a normal child and healthy adult can be legally aborted and thrown out with other "medical waste." "Whoever sheds the blood of man, by man shall his blood be shed; for God made man in His own image." (Genesis 9:6) Surely, it was more than a tumor in Elizabeth's body who "leaped in her womb for joy." (Luke 1:44)

* This Wednesday (January 22) marks the 41st anniversary of the historic Supreme Court decision, Roe vs. Wade, which struck down any laws which opposed the practice of abortion. Since that time the lives of more than 90 million infants haven been terminated simply because they were unwanted. Please join us in praying that this atrocity may one day be overturned.

A Good Conversation

Missie Jenkins wrote the following on her blog back in September.

Have a conversation.... tonight-do everything you can to have a conversation.... let the conversation be worthwhile and happy and full. Let it be something that is honest and serious and deep and yet fun and peaceful and joyful. Have the kind of conversation that can be life changing...one that can make you feel GREAT from the inside out. I share this with you today because I did it and want you to do it too. Yesterday, I was kinda having a down day—I don't know why—but at the end of my night-I spend a long time in a great, great conversation... it changed my heart- it changed my "stinkin- thinkin"- it made me feel-well, amazing. The conversation started with me-sitting outside on my front porch in a rocking chair... all alone with just me and my Father. I talked to Him-I cried out to Him—I begged Him for strength and for a greater faith. I told Him there was no way I could make it through without Him. I told Him that I knew He knew all of my secrets but that I wanted Him to hear them from me-so I confessed to Him. Then I told Him I loved Him. I loved Him so much that I wanted to be better and do better because of Him. I told Him that there was nothing and no one that mattered more to me....and I meant it. I also told Him that I would fail Him again.... but that I wanted to try, to try hard to show Him how much it meant that He had given me life— and not just life but a GREAT LIFE. Then I took out my Bible and I read this passage— read it- I know it is probably in your memory but read it— For God so loved the world that He gave His ONLY son- so that whoever believes in Him would not be lost but have eternal life. — Wow. It was something I needed to see.... it means something- it means He really really loves me. — Have a conversation.

In a time where we are pulled in what seems like a thousand directions with work, school, church activities, entertainment, and who knows what else; Missie's reminder of what is truly important is a breath of fresh air. The bonds we have with family and with God will see us through. She was right when she said, "Wow".

Consider how often Jesus sat with others or with God and simply had a good conversation:

Joh 6:3 And Jesus went up on the mountain, and there He sat with His disciples.

Mar 2:15 Now it happened, as He was dining in *Levi's* house, that many tax collectors and sinners also sat together with Jesus and His disciples; for there were many, and they followed Him.

Mat 24:3 Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be? And what *will* be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?"

Luk 19:5 And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and saw him, and said to him, "Zacchaeus, make haste and come down, for today I must stay at your house."

Luk 10:38 Now it happened as they went that He entered a certain village; and a certain woman named Martha welcomed Him into her house.

Mar 1:35 Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed.

My friends, take a little time today; sit and be with the ones you love, with God, and simply have a *good conversation*...it will do wonders for your soul.
