# DANA'S DIRECTION

"Every child needs to be in Bible Class"



I once read of a man who, as a college student and then a young lawyer, devoted a great deal of attention to the youth of his church and community. He was a bible class teacher, a coach, and a volunteer at a "Boy's and Girl's" center. Eventually, a career in government moved him away from his home and ultimately to an appointment to the bench as a juvenile judge.

He decided, after a twenty year absence, to revisit his home town and see how the young people he had worked with had turned out. There were some surprises. Some of the troubled youth had gone on to be successful. Others, he believed to have great potential, never really lived up to his hopes. But, the one fact that was most encouraging: almost every child that he had taught in bible class had not only turned out well, they had also remained faithful to the church.

God expects parents to provide spiritual guidance for their children. "And you fathers, provoke not your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord." (Eph. 6:4) The old law carried with it instructions for parents to "teach them diligently to your children when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up." (Deut. 6:6-7) Paul attributed the faith of young Timothy to the fact that his mother and grandmother had taught him the scriptures "from childhood." (II Tim. 3:15)

One opportunity that is available to every parent, grandparent, and family at Camden Avenue, is our Bible school. Every Sunday morning and Wednesday evening classes are provided for all ages, children through adult. A child who attends every bible class (not including VBS, youth camp, Bible Bowl and other activities) during the first 18 years of his life, will receive over 14,000 hours of instruction. Although this seems like a lot, it is only a fraction of the time our child is influenced by school, community activities, television and other forms of entertainment. Yes, we must teach our children at home—but are we? The Bible school does not replace our responsibility to teach our children, it is an aid and a supplement to that responsibility. Are 4-5 hours, assembled with the church each week, too great of a commitment to make toward raising our children in the faith?

I have been preaching for over thirty years. My experience has been pretty much the same as the man I mentioned at the beginning of this article. The children I have observed growing up in the church who are faithful as adults and are raising their children in the Lord are—for the most part—the ones I saw every week in Bible class. Give your child every opportunity to know the Lord—make sure they are in every Bible class.

# What Do We Do When...?

What can we do when Satan tempts us to evil? The answer to that question partially lies in our foundation and strength as Christians in the Lord. The influence of our friends, families, and our desire to please God all play an important role in our response to sin. But again, what can we do when we are enticed to follow the world and not God?

Joseph literally *fled* instead of committing sexual sin (Gen 39.12). Jesus *turned* to the truth of God and scripture for strength (Mt 4). We can *pray* for God's help and wisdom against temptation (Mt 6.13) and we can *protect ourselves with the spiritual* armor of God (Eph 6.10-20). As a people, we can *encourage* and strengthen each other (Eph 4.31-32) while helping to bear the burden (Gal 6.2).

So what do we do when the evil that is before us is so large that it feels like there is nothing that can be done to stop it? The Bible shows us that our brothers and sisters in the Lord were persecuted by both the Jews and the Romans. History depicts some truly horrible treatment of Christians as it records the world's war on God. Peter wrote an entire letter addressing the Christian's conduct in this conflict, while providing divine encouragement and hope at the same time (I Pet 4.12-19).

Today, an evil is before us that has grown to such great proportions that it sometimes seems like there is nothing we can do to face it without being crushed. It is an evil supported by our own government. In this case, I am speaking of the murder of millions of innocent children through abortion and abortion inducing drugs. It saddens me that we will risk war with a country that uses chemical weapons to kill thousands (including children); yet 198,000 abortions take place each year due to the drug Mifepristone (formerly known as RU-486), commonly known as the abortion pill. This is a chemical warfare conducted by Americans on an irreprehensible scale against the most innocent of lives.

I encourage you to pray for our country, for our leaders, for the women who have made life ending choices, and those who are contemplating making the same decisions. This is God's world, He is in control, and He hears the prayers of the righteous (Js 5.16).

Additionally, the elders have asked that you consider responding to the *West Virginians for Life* campaign by signing their petition. You see, we are being asked to fund abortions with our tax dollars through the new Affordable Care Act, (ObamaCare), which will go into Law this October first. However, this health care law gives each state the option of preventing state tax dollars from being applied to abortion funding programs if the state legislature specifically chooses to opt out of that portion of the plan.

It is true that sometimes it seems our single voice is too small to make a difference. It is also true that we are to stand against evil in all of its forms, and if we do, God will be with us. No one is greater than God! We have an opportunity to stand up, will you consider taking it?


