

Do you....know it all?

I recently had a conversation with a friend in which this question was asked, "What type of person is the most difficult for you to relate to?" Immediately he said, "I can't stand to be around a *know it all*." Have you ever felt that way? If yes, then what is so frustrating about someone who comes across as a *know it all*? Perhaps these are some things you find annoying:

A know it all never seems to listen, they only talk.

A know it all seems to always believe their opinion is the best, no matter what anyone else has to say.

A know it all cannot be taught anything or shown a new way to do something; after all, they already know that.

A know it all does not value anyone else.

I am sure that you could add many things to this list. Consider this, a *know it all* is a person that needs God most in their life. It will not be long that their friends stop talking to them, their co-workers are angry with them, and their family says things like 'that's just the way they are'. This person has to always be meeting new people and building new relationships, while all the time wondering why their old friends never want to be around them.

Perhaps this is one reason why Jesus said, "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven" (Mt 5.3). A person who is poor in spirit is one who is the opposite in demeanor of the *know it all*. Someone poor in spirit is like an empty glass, just waiting to be filled. This soul seeks out God's knowledge, wisdom, and teaching fills himself with it.

A person who is poor in spirit never becomes full, realizing that there is a never ending supply of wisdom in God. No matter how much they learn about God, there is always room for more. Age does not matter, neither does race, nor background or gender. You can always spot a person who is poor in spirit, they are the ones walking around with a Bible that looks like it has been read a thousand times (because it has) and is falling apart. Mightily blessed are they.

So I ask you: Are you poor in spirit, blessed each day because you realize when it comes to God, 'I can never know it all', but I can search His word daily in order to know more than I knew yesterday?


