

DANA'S DIRECTION

BAPTISM: A RESPONSE OF FAITH

The Lord set baptism as the "faith response" to His grace that would bring salvation to man. In baptism there is found design, order, meaning and beauty. The beauty of baptism is seen in its symbols.

Baptism is a re-enactment of the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ (Romans 6:3-11). It is a birth into a new life (John 3:1-5) and a salvation from the old world of sin (I Peter 3:18-22; Titus 3:5-7). Baptism is the uniting act one experiences in becoming part of Christ and His body, the church (I Corinthians 12:12-14).

Baptism is a beautiful act because of what it depicts. Not only does it portray one's total surrender to the will of God, but it also determines the precise moment that one is washed by the blood of Christ. Salvation from sin requires contact with the redemptive blood. Contact with the blood requires contact with His death. Contact with His death occurs at the point of baptism (Romans 6:3-5).

Baptism is a clearly revealed doctrine in scripture, one of simple beauty and meaning. Baptism is a command of God. Baptism is essential to salvation. Baptism is the "beginning" of the Christian race not the "end". The race to be won requires running by faith, serving God, worshipping regularly and feeding on His word. Baptism "alone" will not save a person's soul. Baptism "alone" is a mere dipping in water, nothing more.

NURSERY REVISIONS

Our Nursery was originally established to help those mothers who needed some assistance with their children during the worship hour. This was especially true for mothers with new born babies who also had other children to deal with during normal worship services. However, over time we have seen a change in the needs of our new mothers. Today we have fewer mothers with young children and fewer children in the individual families. The elders have been approached by some of our present mothers who have babies requesting that the nursery be revised to better reflect their needs. They have indicated that they normally prefer to take care of these babies themselves and they prefer a quiet place to do this.

The elders agree that some changes are needed, so beginning in March 2012, the following revisions will be made to our Nursery:

- * The nursery will no longer be an attended nursery. If specific help is needed by some mothers, the ushers will have a list of available ladies to contact to provide assistance.
- * Additional dividers will be provided in the present Nursery space to allow mothers and/or fathers more privacy.
- * Use of the Nursery should be limited to very young children (those in diapers) with their parent.

The elders hope these changes will provide a better environment for our mothers/fathers and their babies and meet the needs of these families.
