

- $\sqrt{}$ It involved him in the work of God. He put his faith in action and built the Jews a synagogue.
- $\sqrt{10}$ It worked for the good of others. He was concerned about a servant, who under Roman laws was simply viewed as a living tool.
- $\sqrt{}$ It was humble. He felt unworthy before Jesus.
- $\sqrt{}$ It acknowledged that nothing was too hard for God. He believed Jesus could do what he was unable to do.
