DANA'S DIRECTION A Good Word

Mark Twain once said, "I can live for two months on one good compliment." We all know what he meant by that. It lifts your spirits to have someone say something genuinely nice to you or about you."

Solomon noted this human truth when he wrote: "Anxiety in the heart of a man weights it down, but a good word makes it glad" Proverbs 12:25.

Haven't you experienced those days when the morning began just right? Someone in your family noted something special about you that was meaningful to them. Your boss gave you a compliment when you walked through the door. And, then, there was a note in the mail or a phone call from someone you love and words of cheer entered your heart and carried you through the day.

We cannot rearrange any of the requirements or commands to suit ourselves, or to conform to some religious doctrine created by man, and still correctly "spell" the salvation of our souls before God.
