

## CATCHING FISH AND FEEDING SHEEP

"I am going fishing," said Simon Peter. Nothing startling here. Before meeting Jesus Peter had been a fisherman on the sea of Galilee. No novice is he. Catching fish is second nature to him; no one has to explain to him the best procedure to follow. It has been his lifetime work. So when Peter announces his intention of going fishing several of the disciples say, "We will go with you."

Have you ever been on a fishing trip that was unsuccessful? You're not alone. It happened to Peter and his friends. They stayed out all night and caught nothing. Weary and ready to give up, they heard a man on the beach shout, "Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some." Some? They were not able to haul the net in because there were so many. John sensed the truth first, "It is the Lord!" And the next thing you know Peter is out of the boat and swimming toward the Lord.

It has been some three years since Peter and his brother heard the call of Jesus, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."

Now-sitting around a charcoal fire and enjoying the breakfast Jesus has prepared-Peter is given another commission: "Feed my sheep."

The business of the kingdom involves both catching fish and feeding sheep. Jesus plainly said before he ascended into heaven, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age."
