POTTER CHILDREN'S HOME "Silver for Children" COIN BANKS


Coin banks are available in the foyers. The money raised helps take care of the daily expenses of the children. A representative will be here next moth to collect the banks.

Reaching Non-Believers



We live in a world where the majority of the people around us are lost and dying in sin. They are lost because they have never obeyed the gospel of Jesus Christ. As people who probably have friends and family who are lost, what can we do to reach these people?

- 1. **Befriend them**. Jesus ate with sinners and tax collectors, groups of individuals most people chose to avoid (Matthew 9:9-13). Why would Jesus go against the common practice of society? Jesus knew you couldn't lead someone without first befriending them
- 2. Love them. The second greatest command is to love our neighbors as ourselves (Matthew 22:39). Jesus lived this commandments daily. When He saw the crowds of people, Jesus felt compassion for them (Matthew 9:35-36).
- 3. **Serve them**. Jesus came to earth to be a servant (Mark 10:44-45; Philippians 2:5-8). If we want to make a difference in the lives of others and help lead them to Christ, we have to be willing to get our hands dirty (John 13:12-14).
- 4. **Pray for them**. Jesus spent a lot of alone time praying. Don't you suppose at least some of His prayers were devoted to praying for the lost? In the Lord's prayer of John 17, Jesus prayed for 1) Himself, 2) His disciples, 3) Future believers. What better way to reach non-believers than by praying for them on a continual basis and asking God to help you teach them?
- 5. **Teach them**. I know this may seem like one of those "duh" moments, but I think many times we fail to act in this area. Jesus was about the business of teaching (Matthew 4:23; Mark 6:6). How often do we teach those who are lost? As Christians, it's our responsibility to reach out to non-believers and teach them (Matthew 28:19-20; Mark 16:15; Acts 1:8).

Sin is a BIG deal and it's time Christians started treating it that way! Let's open our eyes and ask God to give us opportunities to reach the lost around us (Matthew 9:37-38).

Why I Am a Member of the church of Christ?



"But sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always being ready to make a defense for everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence" (1 Peter 3:15)

For more than 94 years my family has served the Lord as members of the church of Christ. I have no greater blessing and no greater pleasure than to be in His church. The church Jesus built is a family (1 Timothy 3:15), and His kingdom (Matthew 16:18-19). The Lord's church is His bride (Ephesians 5:23-24), and His body (Ephesians 1:22-23).

The church Jesus built is not a denomination; it has no earthly headquarters and no structure above the local congregation. Instead, the church Jesus built is undenominational, predenominational, and anti-denominational. Sometimes people say the church is nondenominational, but this is a little confusing, While some non-denominational churches are not connected with any denomination, they see no error in denominationalism. The Scriptures, however, speak against the division of denominationalism (John 17:20-23; 1 Corinthians 1:10-13; Galatians 5:19-21; Ephesians 4:1-6).

At the heart of everything in the churches of Christ, one finds an unfailing commitment to Scripture and the Lord's way. They are committed to following only the teaching of our Lord; and should they stray from the Word in doctrine or practice, they are committed to returning to the truth. They speak where the Lord speaks and are silent where the Lord is silent, because they love the Lord and want to please Him (John 14:15; Colossians 1:10).

Anyone's greatest privilege is to know the Lord and to be in His family, the church. True Christians want everyone to know the Lord and to be saved (1 Timothy 2:3-4). We preach the pure gospel, because it has the power to save (Romans 1:16). We reject error, because it leads people to be lost (James 5:19-20). We must preach the truth again and again so people might come to know the Lord.

Will you help SEARCH in this noble quest to reach people for the Lord Jesus Christ?

Brent attended here in his teen years with his parents, Harvey and Lisa West.


Brent graduated from Parkersburg High and Holly from Parkersburg South. They are avid Pirate and Buckeye fans.
