

## We are getting ready for Vacation Bible School!

To help us prepare for V.B.S. we will be having Monday Night for the Master tomorrow night at 5:45 p.m. We will begin with dinner, so please sign up if you plan to attend so we can have count for the food preparation. Then about 6:30 p.m. we will divide into our groups to do the work for the evening. The work which will need to be done is as follow:

- We need a group of people to send out invitations to invite families to our V.B.S.
- We need a group of people to pass out V.B.S. invitations to people in the community.
- Teachers will also have an opportunity to begin working in their classrooms.
- There will also be opportunities for those who would like to do visitation.
- There will also be some maintenance items to do around the building.

# V.B.S. will be July 8,9, and 10 and start each evening at 6:30 and dismiss at 8:00.

There will be many things to do at V.B.S. So, we hope you plan to be here and bring your friends. Each evening starts at 6:30 p.m. we will begin with singing. The children will then be dismissed to their classes for a time of Bible study. Then after about 20 minutes in Bible class the children will go either to a fun activity outside or to the MP room for snacks and skits with Doug Wells. Then after 20 minutes at these stations the children will move either to the outside activity or to the MP Room. Then students will return to the auditorium to sing and received the banner awards. We will close each night with a prayer at 8:00 p.m.



There are only 31 chapters in the book of Proverbs and 31 days in the month of July, so that means a person can read one chapter a day for the whole month and complete and read the whole book of Proverbs. As a way to challenge and encourage the Bible reading I would like for those who complete the reading to sign their name on the sheet of paper on the bulletin boards in the foyers. This is just another way to encourage Bible reading and help each member to know more about God's word.

# DOUG'S DISCUSSION



# **Far Reaching Consequences**

God, who alone knows the future, set the regulations for Israel's kings long before the people asked Samuel for one. All the way back in Deuteronomy the law for the king was clearly described. The king must be an Israelite. He must not acquire many horses or go back to Egypt to get more. He shouldn't try for large amounts of silver and gold. And . . . "He must not take many wives, or his heart will be led astray" (Deuteronomy 17:17). Pretty much, if the people just HAD to have a king, God wanted humble and holy kings. These commands for the king were mostly ignored. Solomon broke every single one of these commands.

So why does God tell us that there are certain things to do and certain things to not do? Is it just a test of obedience? Or does God, who knows the future, realize that certain actions will lead to blessings and others will result in major problems? In my estimation if God says to do something we should obey no matter what the reason is . . . He's God. Who are we to ignore the commands of our Creator? But to give even more reason God gives commands not to burden us but to help us. Solomon ignored the command not to take many wives. He super ignored it. Even worse, many of his wives were not Israelites but they were from the nations around them, and so, as predicted in Deuteronomy, "As Solomon grew old, his wives turned his heart after other gods" (1 Kings 11:4).

Of course, choosing to ignore God's commands doesn't just affect us. The generations after us can feel the consequences of our choices, especially if we are in a position of influence. Solomon's son Rehoboam wasn't much of a king. He made terrible choices. His choices were his own but there certainly were some bad influences in his life. "His mother's name was Naamah; she was an Ammonite" (1 Kings 14:21). Solomon married a woman from a country that honored another god, that woman raised her son to worship idols, and later this man led the entire country astray. The God who knows the future gives us these commands for a reason! He knew exactly what would happen if these bad choices were made. The next time you read in scripture about not complaining or loving your wife (or whatever other command there may be) choose to honor what God says. These things are there not to harm you but to give you a hope and a future.
