

# Bring a Friend Next Sunday

Next Sunday, Nov. 10 we are making a special effort to invite our family and friends to our worship services. We are calling it "Family and Friends

services. We are calling it "Family and Friends Day." It is estimated that each Christian knows seven or more people who are not Christians. Think about your relatives, friends, neighbors, classmates, coworkers, or others that you know that do not go to church or are not New Testament Christians? Think about those people in the past week you had a religious conversation with. Think about those you spend the most time with; maybe those people you see at a work or a social event. These are the people we need to invite next Sunday.

Arthur McPhee, states, "The best evangelism takes place in a context of mutual trust and respect. It takes place between friends." We sometimes call this "friendship evangelism." This type of evangelism can be done by each of us. It is spontaneous in nature and based on lifestyle and teachable moments. We do not use a "high-pressure" sales pitch, we do not have to spend money in bringing a speaker in or advertising, just talk to a friend and invite. Sounds Biblical; does it not? After all we see in John 1:40-42 Andrew brought his brother Peter to Jesus, and the woman at the well in John 4 told her whole village. Again, who can we bring to Christ?

Charles (Chuck) Schultheisz, former preacher at the Laings congregation and where I use to preach; shares this about the benefit of "Bring a Friend Day," that took place at Laings some years ago. Chuck states, he was almost two months into his work at Laings, and Roger Starr one of the members at Laings, invited his friend, Darrell Landefeld. Darrell rarely missed a service from that day forward and soon he and Chuck became friends. One year later Darrell came forward on a Sunday night, handing Chuck a note, stating that he wished to come back to the Lord. He remained an active, and faithful part of God's Kingdom up to his death in August 2003.<sup>[1]</sup>

Bring a Friend day made an eternal difference in Darrell's life; just think what it could do for your family and friends. Jesus states in Mark 16:15-16, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned."

Will you go where Jesus is not? Will you "Go" and invite a friend to worship and Bible class next week? Think about it and then do it! MTT

# DOUG'S DISCUSSION

# God's Plans are Better

In a very wise moment Job said to God, "I know that You can do everything, and that no purpose of Yours can be withheld from you" (Job 42:2). In that moment God was planning great things for Job's life (even though I'm sure it didn't seem like it at the time). Life doesn't always go like WE planned, does it? I know people would wanted one kind of job but the market led them to settle for a different career. I have a couple of unmarried friends who I think would like to be married . . . they just haven't found the right one yet. I know of couples who would like to have children but have been unable to do so. So many people have been unable to do or have what they wanted! So many of our plans have been thwarted! But let me make a suggestion before bitterness sets in.

If you do not get something you wanted it may be because God has something better in mind for you. I mean, I get at the time this thought might bring you no comfort. We can get a kind of tunnel vision where all of our focus is on what we want at that moment, and not having it can seem like agony. I get it. I've been there. But have you ever looked back on something you really wanted at the time and you were glad that you didn't get it later? Sometimes we get those kinds of moments of clarity and sometimes we don't, but know this: God's plan is best. For those who willingly submit to that plan God can make good things happen. No purpose of His can be defeated. He can give us something that is better than anything we imagined for ourselves.

The prophet Isaiah shares comfort from God to those who are unable to have children. He tells the barren women and widows to sing and not be afraid (Isaiah 54:1,4). Why? Because "your Maker is your husband – the Lord Almighty is his name – the Holy One of Israel is your redeemer" (Isaiah 54:5). To others who cannot have children God says "Follow me, and you'll have an even greater reward." No, you might not have the blessing you imagined but "to them I will give within my temple and its walls a memorial and a name better than sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name that will not be cut off" (Isaiah 56:5). Do you see? I don't think there's anything wrong with having a dream about how life will go. But if you follow the Lord don't be ashamed or bitter if things don't go like you planned. God just has something better in mind.
