

The Challenge of Evangelism

DOUG'S DISCUSSION

The Sacrifice of Fools

There is no doubt that all of our lives can be worship to God. However, I also believe that when believers assemble together this is a special time of worship. A time that should be approached thoughtfully. It is no small thing to come into the presence of the living God! That's why Solomon advises: "Guard your steps when you go to the house of God. Go near to listen rather than to offer the sacrifice of fools, who do not know that they do wrong" (Ecclesiastes 5:1). In other words, give thought to your ways. Don't offer the sacrifice of fools – who enter into the worship so carelessly they don't realize God is not pleased with what they are doing.

There are many ways we can "guard our steps" and avoid being foolish in worship. For one, we can be thoughtful about our prayers. There are some who are skilled in offering very lengthy and pious sounding prayers. After the 20+ minutes are over most forget everything that was said since they tuned out after the same topics started to get repeated over and over. Don't look at me like that . . . you know it's true. Prayers that are for show are the sacrifice of fools. We would be wise to reflect on this verse: "God is in heaven and you are on earth, so let your words be few" (Eccl. 5:2).

We can guard our steps by meaning what we say to God. Ever made God a promise during the heights of worship that you didn't keep? That is the sacrifice of fools. "When you make a vow to God, do not delay in fulfilling it" (Eccl. 5:4). It is also unwise to sing praises that you don't really mean. Words that are sung on Sunday should be reflected in our lives the rest of the week. Enthusiasm is no substitute for devotion. Have you given thought to your ways? Could you be singing and promising lies without even realizing it? This is not hard to do when we're careless about worship.

Jesus tells a parable in Luke 18 about two men who go to the temple to worship. One is all show, a self-righteous Pharisee. The other man reflects on some of his poor choices and humbles himself before God. One left worship justified and the other did not. If we want God to be pleased with our services we need to be worshiping truthfully, thoughtfully, and out of a pure heart that promotes God over self. Otherwise we are just offering the sacrifice of fools.

"God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."
