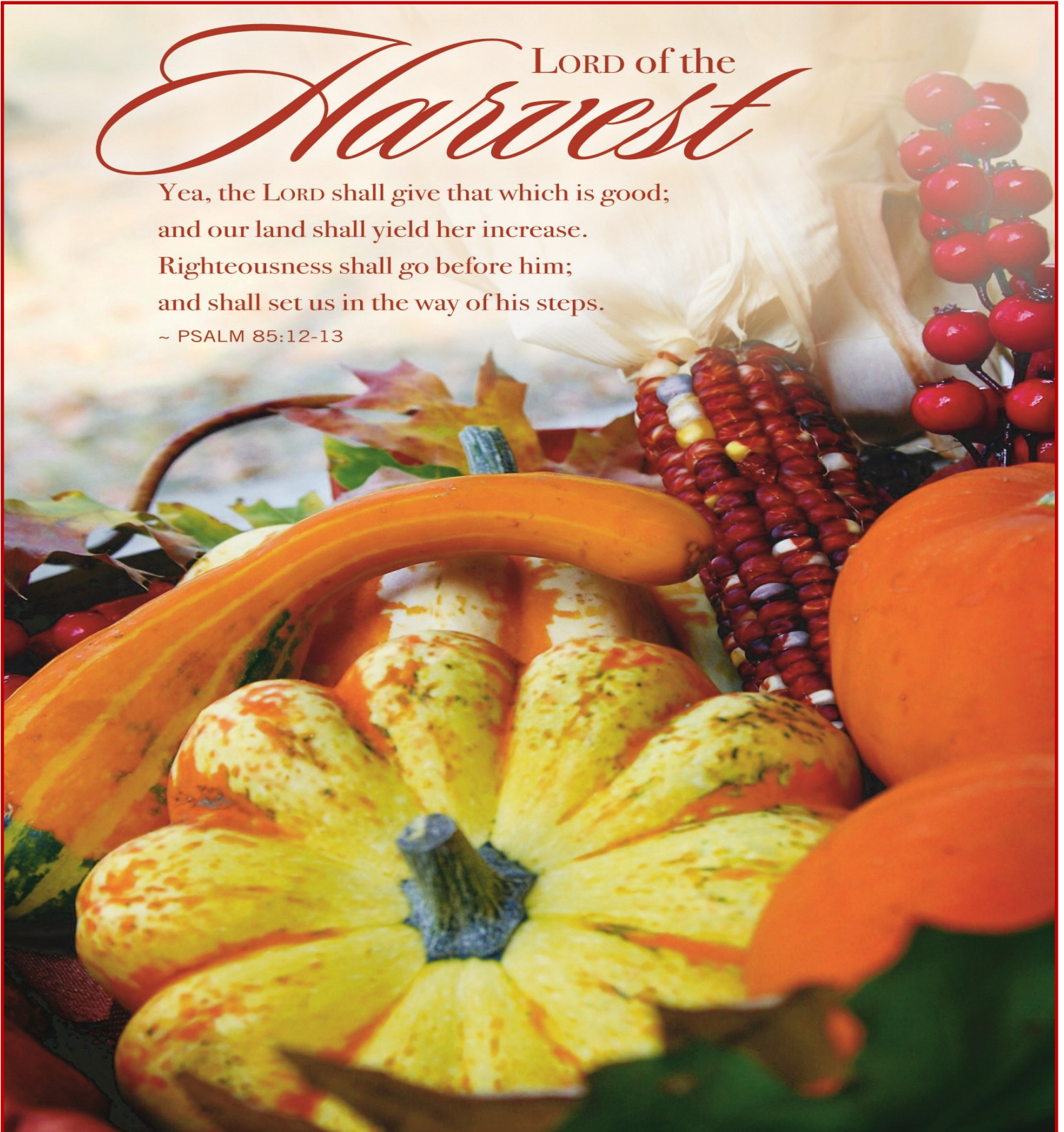

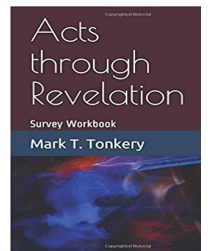
Announcements

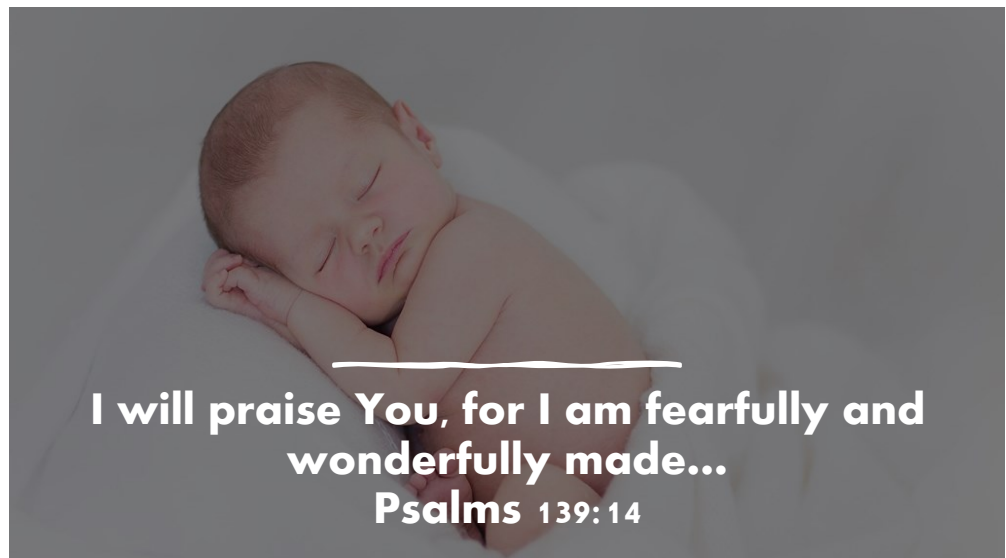
OUTRAGEOUS!

Doug's Discussion

Science Tells Me So

I was reminded of a couple of things in the Science vs. Evolution seminar we just had at Camden Avenue. First of all, thanks to Dr. Jeff Miller for taking the time to make that presentation and to speak to us over a whole weekend. If you missed it watching the sessions online would be well worth your time. Then you too could be reminded that this world changes the story. Hollywood and the secular classroom have become quite skilled at telling the story that the smart people believe in Evolution and the backward degenerates don't. But you don't have to give up your intelligence to come to a saving faith. You just have to give up your stubborn refusal to accept where the truth leads. "The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of people, who suppress the truth by their wickedness, since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them" (Romans 1:18-19).

Science does not disprove God's story of creation. Observable science actually confirms it. (And wouldn't you expect that to be true if God made the world?) In the seminar we went over several scientific laws that make naturalism (which includes Darwin's evolutionary theory) impossible. LAWS – as in there has never been a recorded exception. The Law of Biogenesis basically says that life can only come from life. NEVER has a non-living thing been seen to bring about life. The Law of Conservation says that energy (and matter) cannot be created or destroyed – only transferred from one form to another. Science says that no new energy or matter can "just happen." It must be provided by something outside of the system. The Law of Entropy says everything moves from order to disorder. Our universe isn't getting better – it is decaying. We aren't evolving, we are de-evolving! "What may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them."

The only reason people accept the kind of nonsense that is proclaimed in schools across America is because they have a prior commitment to keep God out of their lives. I believe if anyone is sincere about finding the truth they will find it, and will join the believers who worship the Lord. God says, "You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart" (Jeremiah 29:13). I pray we never get discouraged by the volume of the voices who shout that we don't need God. Know this in your heart and know it always: nothing would exist without Him. All that is made is His. The Bible says so, sure. So does science.

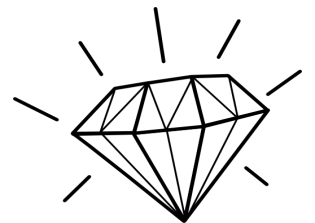
Minute of Meditation by Doug Wells
