A Note from the Elders

November 30, 2021

Bible Class Environment

It is the desire of the elders at Camden Avenue church of Christ that the Bible classes be orderly to allow the teachers to readily convey the lessons they have prepared for the class. A disruptive class environment makes it difficult for the teachers to educate those in the class and it prevents the class from being able to learn.

With those thoughts in mind, the elders make the following suggestions for the Bible Class teachers:

- Items brought to class by students can be a focal point of disruption. These include such things as: toys; candy (wrapped or unwrapped, gum); drinks (water, soft drinks, milk shakes, etc.); snacks (chips, crackers, cookies, etc.); books not associated with the lesson; other disruptive items.
- As students arrive in class, teachers may collect from the students any item which may be a distraction from the lesson.

Those collected items may be held until the end of class when the items are to be returned to the students.

As an alternate approach, when parents bring their children to class, teachers may ask the parents to retain the items which could be a distraction.

Should teachers decide to share snacks, candy, or any other items with the class, teachers may do so at their own discretion. The timing of this type of activity will occur when the teacher determines it best fits with the overall flow of the lessons. As an example, during Vacation Bible School, teachers determine the best time for distributing any cookies and drinks for their class.

These suggestions are made by the elders to help teachers in their efforts to maintain an environment conducive to learning. Teachers can be assured that implementing these guidelines will be supported by the eldership.

This message may be freely shared with teachers, classroom helpers, parents, and all others who care about the spiritual growth of those in our Bible Classes at Camden Avenue church of Christ.
