

<u>Mussel Maker</u>

I am constantly amazed when a television show presents macro-evolution (the idea that one species can transform into a completely different, usually more complex one) as an indisputable fact. Or when the science books in our kid's schools make similar claims. What was once stated to be a theory is almost a given now, and if you don't believe it there's something wrong with you. Well children and television viewers, before you make up your minds completely, allow me to present to you the Lampsilus mussel.

This type of amazing freshwater creature spends the first few weeks of its life growing in a fish's mouth. How did it get there you ask? Good question. The mussel baits a specific fish with what looks like a tasty snack, tailored specifically for that particular fish. Then, at exactly the moment when the fish comes by and gets close enough, the mussel says, "Guess

what? You're going to babysit all my kids!" Then the fish gets blasted with all the super tiny kiddos who get in through the fish's gills. The Lowest Place

In Luke 14 Jesus uses a bunch of people fighting over the good seats as an opportunity to teach people about life. "Don't do that," Jesus says. Because if you plop yourself into the best seat and someone else deserves it more the host might say, "Give this man your seat." Wouldn't that be embarrassing while you walk to the dusty dark corner where the last seat is? But if you are humble, and you take one of the seats in the back, the host might say, "Friend, move up to a better place." Then, you're honored in front of everyone. Jesus's conclusion in Luke 14:11 is, "For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

Here is the lesson: Praise others instead of yourself. Think about how someone else could benefit instead of only thinking about how you can get ahead. And if someone is sitting in your normal seat, by all means, go get a different one, even if it isn't as good of a view. Why? 
