# Actions and Consequences

In this world actions have consequences – despite enormous efforts to circumvent them. The Bible states this principle simply in Galatians 6:7, "Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows." Sow carrots and you get carrots. Sow evil and you get evil returns. Do you believe that? Or do you believe that you are the one person who is so stealthy or so intelligent that you can avoid reaping the consequences? Someone may think the hangover from last night's party can be defeated with Advil, or that the unwanted pregnancy from the one-night stand can be overcome with a visit to the clinic. So there, God! Consequences adverted. But God cannot be mocked . . . unforeseen consequences abound, and lives are ruined and ended from every direction when people do what is evil.

That's why the Bible makes it clear that it is a good idea to never divorce the two concepts of action and consequence. This should start when our children are very little. "Discipline your son, for in that there is hope; do not be a willing party to his death" (Proverbs 19:18). Why should we refuse to "spare the rod"? If our young children learn that a bad choice is connected to a painful consequence they have gained a very valuable lesson. So-called "progressive" parents are starting to really frown on the idea of this kind of discipline, or

any kind of discipline really. Many of them are willing parties to their children's death – as their child never connects action and consequence. In fact, bad action often results in getting exactly what they wanted in the first place – the completely wrong lesson. Should we be surprised at the results we see in the world around us?

Later in life, those who didn't learn this lesson as a child get themselves into trouble. And perhaps you are in a position to bail them out; to absorb their penalty for them. Let me offer a bit of wisdom from the next proverb, "A hot-tempered man must pay the penalty: if you rescue him, you will have to do it again" (Proverbs 19:19). Why would you have to do it again? Because this person has never connected actions and consequences. Sometimes the most loving thing to do for someone is to let them face the music. If they really have to pay for something they did, then perhaps they learn the lesson that what we do in this life matters. The way we act matters. And by faith, we know that one day we will answer for our conduct, whether it is good or evil, and that ultimately there is no avoiding the consequences of our choices. I pray we all have learned this lesson well.
